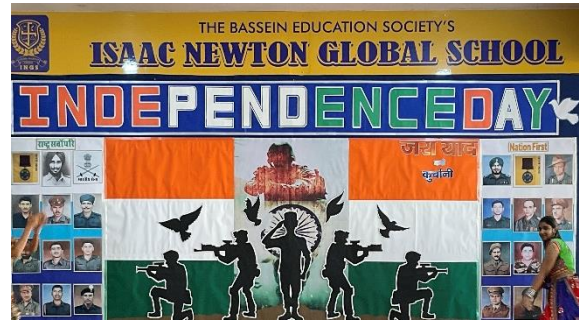




INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION
